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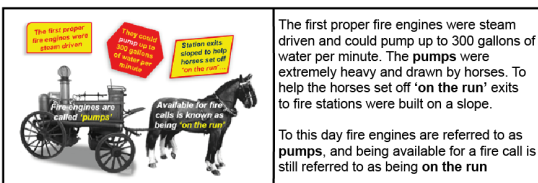
### Interactive fire engine presentation

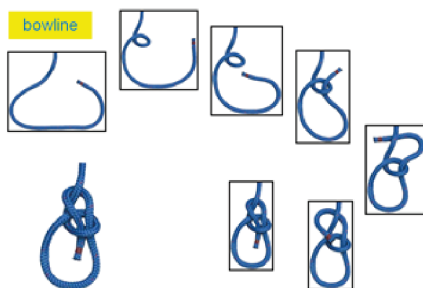


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Covering the history of Royal Navy influences and terminology which is linked to the modern fire service which we see today

### Knots and lines presentation



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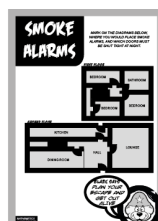
Powerpoint presenting step-by-step instructions and animations of Royal Navy knots which are still used by today's fire service including:

### Learning objectives

2. I know how to reduce fire hazards
3. I know what actions to take in a house fire
4. I know what to do if my clothes catch fire

By the end of these lessons, pupils will be able to: recognise and reduce the most common fire hazards; carry out a Fire Safety Check in their home; know the bed time routine; know what actions to take if cut off by fire; know the correct actions to take in the event of a fire; demonstrate the correct actions to take should their clothes catch fire.

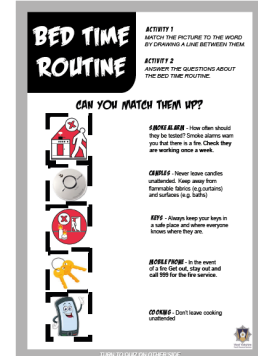
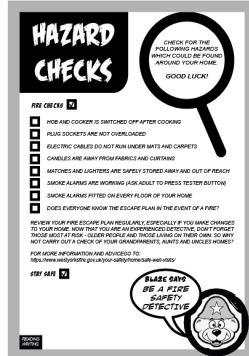
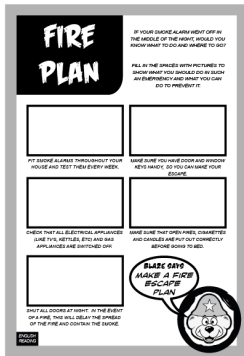
Watch the video then practice Stop, Drop and Roll. Pause the video at the designated places to answer the questions in the caption.

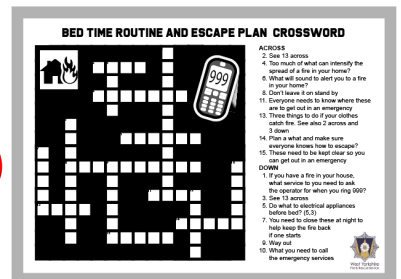
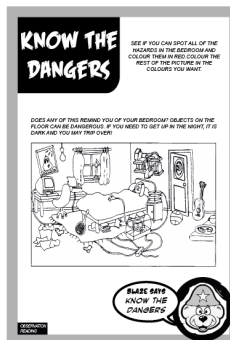
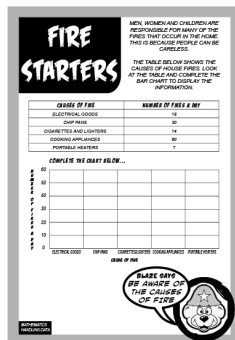
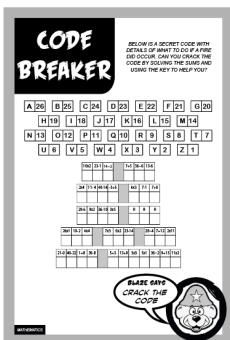


Follow instructions to complete a fire plan for your home

Complete the crossword to re-cap and embed key messages relating to the bed time routine and escape plan



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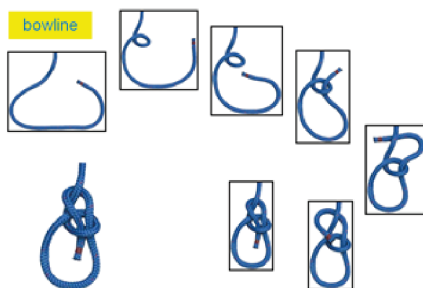


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
